- Augmentative equipment for students with speech and language disabilities

- Financial assistance to meet critical needs of students with disabilities
- A Leadership Academy for high school students with special needs
- Arts in the Classroom to bring art, music and dance to students
- Special projects for the five Special School District schools and two technical high schools in St. Louis County

## Growth in the special education population is significant both nationally and locally.

Today, the Special School District serves approximately 25,000 students with disabilities across St. Louis County. Special education is costly; having a disability is expensive.
